General information:

- Each team needs to be comprised of 6-8 players (male or female).
- Players have to be BP Members by deadline for confirmation of the team.
- Fee has to be paid by deadline for confirmation of Regional Playoffs.
- There's only one national division (for this 1st edition).
- Groups divided by regions.
- Deadline for confirmation of team members for Regional Playoffs: **April 15th, 2019.**
- Deadline for confirmation of team members for National Finals: **September 12th, 2019.**

- 20 teams have registered;
- Teams have been geographically allocated in 4 regional groups for qualifications phase;
- Groups are: Group North, Group South A, Group South B and Group South C.

1. GROUP NORTH

- The Regional Playoff will be hosted on the 11th of May 2019, at Middlesbrough Padel Club;
- A Round Robin format will be played;
- Six players per team will participate in each team encounter;
- Each team encounter will consist of three matches in total;
- The pairings must be confirmed 30-minutes before the start of each encounter. Any of the eight players can be selected for the line-up (only three pairs). See line-up rules below.
- Each match won will count as 1 point;
- Matches will be played to the best of 3 sets with a 10 point tie breaker as the third;

4. GROUP SOUTH C

- Each team encounter will consist of three matches in total;
- The pairings must be confirmed 30-minutes before the start of each encounter. Any of the eight players can be selected for the line-up (only three pairs). See line-up rules below.
- Each match won will count as 1 point;
- Matches will be played to the best of 3 sets with a 10 point tie breaker as the third;

NATIONAL PLAYOFFS:

- Location to be confirmed, on the 21st and 22nd of September 2019;
- 8 teams make their way to the national finals, and will be devised into 2 groups for a Round Robin qualifying as follows:

Group Final 1	Group Final 2
North Winner	North Runner-up
South A Runner-up	South A Winner
South B Winner	South B Runner-up
South C Runner-up	South C Winner

- Each team will be allowed to enlist a maximum of four new additional players (who have not played for another team in the Regional Playoffs);
- Confirmation on attendance and list of players have to be completed 10 days before the event (deadline 2.00pm 12th of September 2019);
- Six players per team will participate in each team encounter;
- Each team encounter will consist of three matches in total;
- The pairings must be confirmed 30-minutes before the start of each encounter. Any of the eight players can be selected for the line-up (only three pairs). See line-up rules below.
- Each match won will count as 1 point;
- Matches will be played to the best of 3 full sets;
- Balls will be provided by the organisation.
- Lucky Loser / Wildcard will be offered to teams from the Regional Playoffs should any qualified teams withdraw from the National Finals (the next qualified in the group of the withdrawn team);
- In case of tie between two teams, the winner will be based on the winner of the encounter between tied teams;



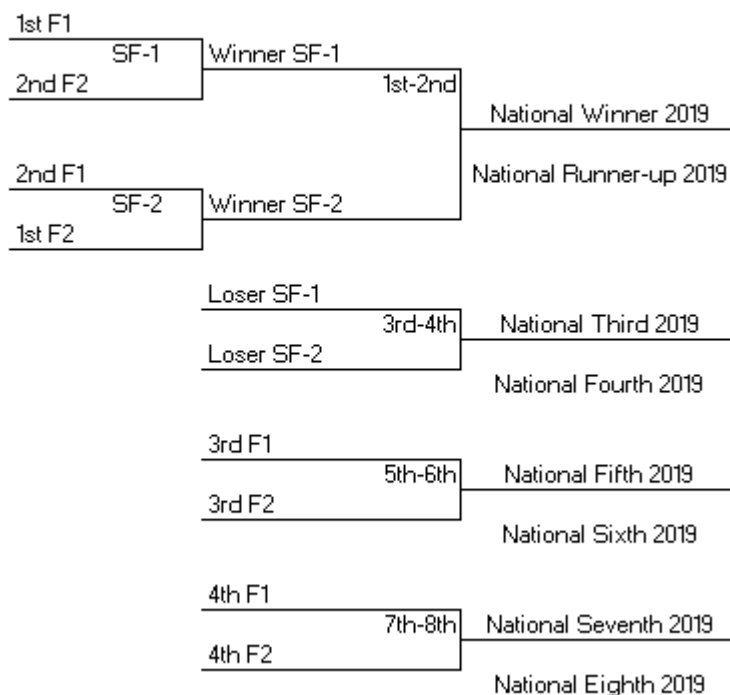

- In case of tie between three teams, the winner will be based first on the number of points; if tie continues, on the difference of sets won/lost; finally, if tie continues, will be based on the difference of games won/lost. - The best two teams per subgroup will qualify to Regional Semi-finals;
- Balls will be provided by the organisation;
- A Final round for each position will be played to determine national club rankings.

LINE-UP RULES:

- Line-up rules apply to Regional Playoffs and National Finals;
- UK ranking points obtained from the British Padel Tour will be used as reference to determine pairings: Pair 1 should be the highest ranked pair within the team, followed by pair 2 and by pair 3;
- **Important.** It doesn't mean that the 2 highest ranked players have to play together.
- For example:
 - Player 1: 3,000 points
 - Player 2: 2,800 points
 - Player 3: 1,700 points
 - Player 4: 1,000 points
 - Player 5: 600 points
 - Player 6: 0 points
 - A possible combination would be:
 - Pair 1: Player 2 and Player 4 → total 3,800 points
 - Pair 2: Player 1 and Player 6 → total 3,000 points
 - Pair 3: Player 3 and Player 5 → total 2,300 points

TEAMS CONFIRMATION:

PLAYERS

- Each team will register a minimum of 8 players.
- It's important that all players have active **British Padel memberships** (each individual player should complete this via our website, indicating the name of their home club).
- Captain should confirm their 8 player line-ups before the following deadlines:
 - Regional Playoffs: before 15th of April 2019;
 - National Finals: before 1st of September 2019, if the club has qualified.
- **Important.** Players can only represent one club during each calendar year.

REGISTRATION FEE: £125 per team (special rates apply to BP Affiliated Clubs**)

****AFFILIATED CLUB**

Make sure your club affiliation status is up to date and your renewal for 2019 has been received. **The £125 team fee is waived for all Affiliated Clubs** with two or more courts.

- Courts with an affiliation fee inferior to the £125 should make a payment to British Padel for the difference). For example, if a club affiliation fee were £75/annum an additional payment of £50 would be due in order to complete sign-up into the National Club League.
